DRIVING DIRECTIONS (VERY SCENIC ROUTING):

DRIVERS FROM DENVER ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO DRIVE THROUGH THE INDEPENDENCE PASS. THIS IS A SECTION OF COLORADO ROUTE 82 THAT RUNS SOUTHEAST OF ASPEN FOR APPROX. 25 MILES. IT OFFERS SOME OF THE MOST STUNNING VISTAS IN THE UNITED STATES. EVEN IN EARLY JUNE, THE INDEPENDENCE PASS WILL LIKELY HAVE SNOW AND ICE.

AT 12,095 FEET (3687 METERS), (THE INDEPENDENCE) PASS RANKS AS ONE OF THE HIGHEST PAVED ROADS IN NORTH AMERICA. THE VIEWS FROM UP TOP ARE STUNNING AND BORDER ON THE KIND NORMALLY ONLY RESERVED FOR NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC PHOTOGRAPHERS. THE DRIVE FROM ASPEN IS EQUALLY STUNNING AS THE HIGHWAY ZIGZAGS PAST THICK STANDS OF PINE, TOWERING CLIFFS, STREAMS AND INDEPENDENCE GHOST TOWN. HAIRPIN TURNS WITH
